8 January - 28 February 2021 (40 hours)

The course is an intensive-writing long-term exercise that consisted of 7 modules, 6 of which were devoted to the study of parts of a research article and the development of skills of writing (abstract, introduction, literature review, methods, results and discussion). Module 7 was a final project where, with a set of concepts, models and methods that have been discussed and practiced in the previous weeks, participants had to craft an extended model of their research using materials obtained from the course.

Course Aims were:

- to become familiar with the research article structure
- to learn how to design a research article
- to practice analytical and synthesis skills in writing an article
- to develop skills in academic reading
- to exercise the academic writing skills
- to study useful operational phrases for writing an academic article

Course modules were:

Module One: Introduction to WARA and Writing an Abstract
Module Two Overview: Writing an Introduction
Module Three: Literature Review
Module Four: Methods in Research
Module Five: Results
Module Six: Discussion
Module Seven: Final Project
